IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDICIAL OFFICER

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a judicial misconduct complaint against the judge assigned to his case. The complainant repeatedly states that he is not attacking the substance of the judge's rulings, only that the judge has improper motives to enter the orders in complainant's case. Complainant requests an order to provide medical treatment and to appoint another lawyer to help complainant.

Although complainant alleges ex parte contact with the defendants' lawyers, he sets forth nothing other than his unsupported allegations. Complainant also complains about unreasonable delay in rulings by the judge. A review of the court's docket established that the judge has been very diligent in handling this case.

As the complaint lacks evidence of judicial misconduct, it is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(iii).
