MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a judicial misconduct complaint against the judge assigned to complainant's case. Although the rules suggest a brief statement of facts constituting the misconduct, complainant has filed a lengthy complaint about the judge and opposing counsel and rearguing the errors in the judge's rulings. There are many allegations of bias against the judge. I have reviewed the complaint and the docket and conclude that there is nothing in the judge's language and actions that constitute misconduct. If the judge erred in the rulings, those can be appealed after a final decision.

This complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii) and (iii).
