IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST SEVEN JUDGES:

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed complaints arising from many state and federal cases that complainant filed over the last thirty years. Complainant names seven federal judges who had rendered adverse decisions to the complainant. One is a resigned judge, two are retired judges, and four are judges still hearing cases. The complaint alleges, among other things, that the judges conspired against complainant “to deny him the right to petition, the equal protection of the law and have engaged in criminal conduct.” The complaint also includes a wide range of conspiracy allegations against federal executive lawyers and workers, state judges, municipal workers, Attorney Registration and Disciplinary Commission officials, and others. Complainant sets forth many allegations, but there is no evidence that these judges engaged in any judicial misconduct.

The complaints are dismissed as frivolous pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii).
