

To ensure your continued receipt of Notices of Docket Activity (NDA's), it is recommended that you contact your Internet Service Providers (ISP's) and request they add the U.S. Court's mail servers new IP addresses and/or Domain Naming Service (DNS) names to their e-mail white lists. The Court Administrative Office's Postmaster has already notified the larger ISP's (such as Hotmail and Yahoo).

Below is a list of the mail server DNS entries and the associated IP addresses. There are two IP's for every DNS for redundancy purposes, so, each address should be entered in your ISP's e-mail white list.

A shutdown to make these changes is scheduled for Friday, December 3, 2010 at 10:00 PM Eastern Time. All systems are expected to be back in operation with the new ip-addresses by Saturday, December 4, 2010 at 2:00 AM Eastern Time.
