Re: Limited "ECF" Registration

The current "ECF" registration process for the Seventh Circuit will be for these purposes:

- To allow parties to confirm the desire to receive e-mail notices of docket activity (NDA's), and to state preferences as to type of e-mail notice parties wish to receive (notice per docket entry or docket activity summaries);
- To allow registration of a party's PACER login to be registered with our server so parties can achieve broader access for cases covered under Appellate Rule 25, and new Bankruptcy Rule 9037, Civil Rule 5.2, and Criminal Rule 49.1. (These rules regarding privacy became effective December 1, 2007.)
- To allow parties to submit briefs electronically via ECF in lieu of the former brief upload system.
