NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

Pursuant to <u>General Order 22-005</u>, before entering this courtroom, you certify that you have read and understood the following self-certification requirements:

- 1. If you have recently tested positive for COVID-19, that you have isolated for the requisite 5 days pursuant to applicable CDC guidance, your symptoms are either nonexistent or improving, and you have been fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication;
- 2. If unvaccinated, you have not within the previous 5 days had known close contact with a person who has COVID-19; and
- 3. You have not within the previous 5 days experienced symptoms consistent with COVID-19, including a temperature of more the 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, chills, muscle or body aches, nausea or vomiting, or new loss of taste or smell.

Face masks are not required, except that persons who have tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 6-10 days or have had close contact in the past 5 days with a person who has COVID-19 should follow current masking guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.
