

# NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

Pursuant to General Order 22-005, before entering this courtroom, you certify that you have read and understood the following self-certification requirements:

1. If you have recently tested positive for COVID-19, that you have isolated for the requisite 5 days pursuant to applicable CDC guidance, your symptoms are either nonexistent or improving, and you have been fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication;
2. If unvaccinated, you have not within the previous 5 days had known close contact with a person who has COVID-19; and
3. You have not within the previous 5 days experienced symptoms consistent with COVID-19, including a temperature of more the 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, chills, muscle or body aches, nausea or vomiting, or new loss of taste or smell.

**Face masks are not required, except that persons who have tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 6-10 days or have had close contact in the past 5 days with a person who has COVID-19 should follow current masking guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.**
