IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a judicial misconduct complaint against the chief judge of the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit and a Supreme Court justice. The Judicial Conduct and Disability Act of 1980, 28 U.S.C. §§ 351-364, does not cover the activities of Supreme Court justices. The allegations against the chief judge are that he has failed to comply with complainant's request to investigate Executive Branch employees who allegedly committed criminal activity. The chief judge has no responsibility to do so. This complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(a)(i) and Rule 11(c)(1)(G) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings.
