

New Opinions Interface

Due to the obsolescence of the software used to create the original opinions interface, it has been re-written. This new interface includes additional options for finding concurrences and dissents, searching and RSS feeds.

Concurrences and Dissents

Previously, concurrences and dissents were not published in the system and were merely posted under the majority's author. Now, these items are posted under the author of the concurrence or dissent in addition to the majority opinion.

Searching

Under the new opinions interface you may still search for opinions written today, in the past week and month as well as by case number. Additionally, you may search a date range, a date range plus the author, or using wild cards, a case number range.

RSS

As before, you may subscribe to an RSS feed that will provide you with all newly published opinions. Also, be aware that you will re-subscribe to the new RSS feed. You may now also specify RSS feeds for particular authoring judges you may be following.

Current Limitation

Because of the need to switch to more up-to-date software quickly, you will only find opinions authored at the beginning of the calendar year 2008 and forward. It is our intention to increase the availability of older opinions as our development of this system continues. We regret any inconvenience this may cause.
