

## **Services to the Hearing Impaired and Others with Communication Disabilities**

The United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit will provide reasonable accommodations to persons with communications disabilities. The court will provide sign language interpreters or other auxiliary aids and services to participants in oral arguments who are deaf, hearing impaired or have communication disabilities. The court may provide these services to others, including spectators, only if the court deems it appropriate.

Participants who require these services must contact the Clerk's Office at (312) 435-5850 at least three weeks prior to oral argument to allow the clerk adequate time to make necessary arrangements. Anyone providing their own services, at their own expense, should advise the clerk's office at least two days prior to oral argument so proper accommodations can be made in the courtroom.
