IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST FOUR JUDGES

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a judicial misconduct complaint against four judges who have ruled against him. The complaint is about delay in ruling, denial of extended time for discovery, and misreading the trial court record. Complainant requests that the underlying judgment be vacated.

Any complaint that is "directly related to the merits of a decision or procedural ruling" must be dismissed. 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii). See also Rule 11(c)(1)(B) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings. "Any allegation that calls into question the correctness of an official action of a judge...is merits related." Standard 2 for Assessing Compliance with the Act, *Implementation of the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act of 1980: A Report to the Chief Justice* 145 (2006). This complaint deals with the judges' rulings.

Therefore this complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii).
