IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a complaint against a judge assigned to his case. The complainant states that it is not a complaint about the judge's decision but about what the judge said in the decision and from the bench. The complainant believes that the statements are prejudicial against him. Although complainant states that he is not complaining about the judge's decision, he is complaining about the judge's reasoning in support of that decision. As the complaint is "directly related to the merits of a decision," it is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii) and Rule 11 (c)(1)(B) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings.
