IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST THREE JUDGES

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed this complaint against three judges. He is no stranger to federal litigation as he has had many cases. He requests “a public apology [for his previous losses] and a permanent right to have a panel for [his] cases that consists of judges from other circuits.” This complaint lacks sufficient evidence to raise an inference that misconduct has occurred.

Repetitive filing of insubstantial judicial misconduct complaints is an abuse of the provisions of the Judicial Conduct and Disabilities Act of 1980, 28 U.S.C. §351-364. If complainant continues to abuse the provisions of the Act, I will ask the Seventh Circuit Judicial Council to require complainant to post a \$1,000 bond before any future complaints are reviewed.

A reading of this complaint shows that it is frivolous so it is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(iii).
