IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a judicial misconduct complaint against the judge who dismissed his complaint. The complaint contains many unsupported allegations, but seems to be really about the dismissal of the underlying lawsuit. Any complaint that is “directly related to the merits of a decision or procedural ruling” must be dismissed. 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii). *See also* Rule 11(c)(1)(B) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings. “Any allegation that calls into question the correctness of an official action of a judge...is merits related.” Standard 2 for Assessing Compliance with the Act, *Implementation of the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act of 1980: A Report to the Chief Justice* 145 (2006). This part of the complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii).

The complaint is also dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(iii) as the unsupported allegations lack any evidence to raise an inference that misconduct occurred.
