MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a judicial misconduct complaint against the judge assigned to her case. The complaint is an attack on the judge's rulings. This is complainant's second misconduct complaint and I previously dismissed her complaint against the judges that affirmed the complained about judge in this case. As I said then: "Any complaint that is 'directly related to the merits of a decision or procedural ruling' must be dismissed. 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii). *See also* Rule 11(c)(1)(B) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings. 'Any allegation that calls into question the correctness of an official action of a judge...is merits related.'" Standard 2 for Assessing Compliance with the Act, *Implementation of the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act of 1980: A Report to the Chief Justice* 145 (2006).

This complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii).
