IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST TWO JUDGES

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a judicial misconduct complaint against two judges assigned to his case. The complaint is that the judges committed misconduct through rulings made on multiple motions and other matters in his pending case. Any complaint that is "directly related to the merits of a decision or procedural ruling" must be dismissed. 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii). *See also* Rule 11(c)(1)(B) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings. "Any allegation that calls into question the correctness of an official action of a judge...is merits related." Standard 2 for Assessing Compliance with the Act, *Implementation of the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act of 1980: A Report to the Chief Justice* 145 (2006).

Complainant also make several allegations against attorneys, witnesses and other non-judicial persons. These complaints against non-judicial persons cannot be considered under the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act of 1980. *See* Rules 4 and 8(d) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings.

This complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii).
