MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a judicial misconduct complaint against the judge assigned to her case. The complaint is that the judge was biased and prejudiced because he granted summary judgment and rendered other rulings adverse to her. The judge's rulings are merits related and cannot be reviewed through a complaint under the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act of 1980, 28 U.S.C. §351-64. Any complaint that is "directly related to the merits of a decision or procedural ruling" must be dismissed. 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii). See also Rule 11(c)(1)(B) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings. "Any allegation that calls into question the correctness of an official action of a judge...is merits related." Standard 2 for Assessing Compliance with the Act, Implementation of the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act of 1980: A Report to the Chief Justice 145 (2006).

This complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii).
