ORDER

The Judicial Council of the Seventh Circuit* has reviewed the complainant's petition for review of the memorandum and order entered by Chief Judge Diane S. Sykes on June 21, 2021, dismissing the complaint in the above-captioned matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii). Having considered the relevant materials, the Judicial Council denies the petition for review and affirms the Chief Judge Sykes's memorandum and order.
