IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE

MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

The complainant filed a misconduct complaint against the judge who denied his 2013 petition for a “writ of attachment.” He alleges that the clerk’s office committed numerous “clerical errors” and “fraudent[ly]” concealed a document in his case from “public view” on the docket.

The complainant’s allegations solely concern the actions of the clerk of court and are not within the purview of the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act. 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(i).

Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed pursuant to § 352(b)(1)(A)(i). The complainant may petition the Judicial Council of the Seventh Circuit for review of this order in accordance with Rule 18(b) of the *Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings*. *Id.* § 352(c); see RULES FOR JUD.-CONDUCT & JUD.-DISABILITY PROC. r. 11(g)(3). A petition for review must be filed in the clerk’s office of the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit not later than 42 days of the date of this order.
