MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

The complainant filed a misconduct complaint against the judge who dismissed his civil case. His complaint does not contain a statement of facts describing the alleged misconduct. Instead, he refers to an attached docket-entry notification that includes a hand-written notation at the top stating "claim of public breach of trust 760 ILCS 3/1002."

The complaint is frivolous and wholly unsupported. Allegations of misconduct must be supported by sufficient facts to raise an inference that misconduct occurred. 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii). The complaint also is not in conformity with the requirements of the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act because it fails to contain a statement of the facts supporting the claim of misconduct. *Id.* § 352(b)(1)(A)(i); *see* RULES FOR JUD.-CONDUCT & JUD.-DISABILITY PROC. r. 6(b) ("A complaint must contain a concise statement that details the specific facts on which the claim of misconduct or disability is based.").

Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed pursuant to § 352(b)(1)(A)(i) and (iii).
