IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST TWO JUDGES

MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

The complainant, a federal prisoner, filed separate but overlapping misconduct complaints against a district judge who presided in one of his criminal cases and another district judge who denied his motion seeking postconviction relief in a different criminal case. The complainant vigorously complains about the actions of several other judges who have presided in various of his criminal cases over the years. Regarding these two judges, however, the complainant simply repeats allegations that were contained in two unrelated misconduct complaints that were filed against the judges by other complainants early this year. Those misconduct complaints were dismissed in March. The complainant makes no independent misconduct allegations against the two judges.

Accordingly, the complaints are dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii) because they lack any evidence supporting an inference of misconduct. The complainant may petition the Judicial Council of the Seventh Circuit for review of this order in accordance with Rule 18(b) of the *Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings*. *Id.* § 352(c); *see* RULES FOR JUD.-CONDUCT & JUD.-DISABILITY PROC. r. 11(g)(3). A petition for review must be filed in the clerk's office of the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit not later than 42 days of the date of this order.
