IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST THREE JUDGES

MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

On October 24, 2024, the complainant—a serial filer of frivolous misconduct complaints—filed yet another misconduct complaint, this time against three circuit judges who issued an order limiting the scope of one of his appeals. This new complaint, like the others, is rambling and incoherent. The complainant broadly accuses the judges of discriminating against him because of his religion, but these allegations are utterly unsupported and frivolous and therefore must be dismissed. 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii).

Accordingly, the complaints are dismissed pursuant to § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii). The complainant may petition the Judicial Council of the Seventh Circuit for review of this order in accordance with Rule 18(b) of the *Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings*. 28 U.S.C. § 352(c); see RULES FOR JUD.-CONDUCT & JUD.-DISABILITY PROC. r. 11(g)(3). A petition for review must be filed in the clerk's office of the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit not later than 42 days of the date of this order.
