## IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE

## MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

The complainant, a former state prisoner, filed a misconduct complaint against the judge who dismissed his case against prison officials claiming that they failed to accommodate his disability. He alleges that the judge failed to forward a screening order to the court of appeals.

A misconduct complaint must contain sufficient facts to raise an inference that misconduct has occurred. 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii). This complaint contains no allegations of misconduct. The court of appeals has electronic access to the district court record on appeal, including all orders and documents in the case.

Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed pursuant to § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii). The complainant may petition the Judicial Council of the Seventh Circuit for review of this order in accordance with Rule 18(b) of the *Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings. Id.* § 352(c); *see* RULES FOR JUD.-CONDUCT & JUD.-DISABILITY PROC. r. 11(g)(3). A petition for review must be filed in the clerk's office of the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit not later than 42 days of the date of this order.
