Redaction Methodology Suggestions

- 1. Completely delete sensitive information in the original word processing document and replace it with innocuous filler characters such as 'X', save it, then convert the document to a PDF.
- 2. Read the <u>NSA primer</u> that explains how to check for other potentially sensitive information that might be hidden in a *Word* document's metadata.

In *WordPerfect 13* and *WordPerfect 15*, simply select File, and Save Without Metadata.

- 3. Adobe Acrobat's redaction tool when used to remove sensitive material directly from a .pdf file is effective. Please see your version of Acrobat's Help instructions regarding the proper use of this tool.
- 4. It is recommended that a redacted document be cut and pasted into another document. If the redaction succeeded, no redacted text should be transferred.
