IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDICIAL OFFICER

MEMORANDUM

Complainant is a federal prisoner. He accuses the trial judge of misconduct, but the particulars of his grievance are hard to discern.

Three months ago, complainant filed a materially identical grievance. I dismissed that complaint (No. 07-09-90072) on the basis of 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii), which provides that the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act of 1980 cannot be used to contest judicial decisions. The current complaint ignores both the statute and my prior ruling. It is summarily dismissed. Any further, similar complaint will lead me to initiate the Judicial Council's process for restricting the filing of repetitious, frivolous complaints.
