IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDICIAL OFFICER

MEMORANDUM

Complainant contends that he was abducted by state officials and chained to a bed in a police lockup. According to the complaint, he recognized that one of the guards was a federal district judge. He contends that the judge committed misconduct.

Federal district judges do not moonlight as guards at police lockups, and the complaint is dismissed as frivolous. 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(iii). “[W]hen the allegations are facially incredible or so lacking in indicia of reliability that no further inquiry is warranted, dismissal under this subsection is appropriate.” Commentary to Rule 11 of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings.
