MEMORANDUM

Complainant asserts that a judge has lost the mental acuity necessary for effective performance of judicial duties and, among other matters concerning the judge's private life, has not kept an oral agreement made with complainant.

A chief judge may "conclude the proceeding if ... action on the complaint is no longer necessary because of intervening events." 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(2). See also Rule 11(e) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings. The judge in question has retired and will not perform any judicial function after the end of 2012. Action on this complaint is therefore unnecessary, and the proceeding is concluded.
