# IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST THREE JUDGES

### MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a judicial misconduct complaint against the three judges assigned to his case. The complaint is that the judges were religiously and personally prejudiced against the complainant, went outside of the record in deciding the complainant's case, and lied about the complainants' claims. Complainant has requested a new appeal.

Any complaint that is "directly related to the merits of a decision or procedural ruling" must be dismissed. 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii). See also Rule 11(c)(1)(B) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings. "Any allegation that calls into question the correctness of an official action of a judge...is merits related." Standard 2 for Assessing Compliance with the Act, *Implementation of the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act of 1980: A Report to the Chief Justice* 145 (2006). That describes this complaint.

Therefore this complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii).
