IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a judicial misconduct complaint against the judge assigned to his case. He has filed three other complaints against judges which have been dismissed as frivolous or directly related to the judge's rulings. A reading of this complaint established that it is both frivolous and is directly related to the judge's rulings. If complainant does not make a serious effort to address the effect of 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A), I will suggest that an order be entered by the Judicial Council to require complainant to post a bond of \$1,000 to curtail complainant's frivolous invocations of the 1980 Act. I dismiss the complaint under 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii) and (iii) because the complaint lacks sufficient evidence to raise an inference that misconduct has occurred.
