IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a judicial misconduct complaint against the judge assigned to his case and a member of the court staff. I previously dismissed complainant's earlier complaint against a different judge and the same court staff member. As I stated before, the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act only applies to judges, not court staff.

The substance of this complaint is that complainant is not being treated fairly and that a mailing was delayed. There is no judicial misconduct.

Complainant is warned that if the complainant files future similar judicial misconduct complaints not in compliance with the statute, I will suggest that the Seventh Circuit Judicial Council take steps to curtail misuse of the statute.

This complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(iii).
