IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDICIAL OFFICER

ORDER

After screening this judicial misconduct complaint, Chief Judge Easterbrook appointed a special committee to conduct an investigation of the complaint pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 353(a) and Rule 11(f) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings. At the conclusion of its work, the special committee reported and recommended to the Judicial Council that the complaint be dismissed as factually

unsubstantiated and/or concluded based on voluntary corrective actions having been taken. *See* U.S.C. § 354(a)(1)(B). The Council is satisfied that the complaint is factually unsubstantiated and, where appropriate, voluntary corrective actions have been taken and therefore has voted to accept the special committee's recommendation.

Therefore, by order of the Judicial Council of the Seventh Circuit, this complaint proceeding is hereby DISMISSED. Pursuant to Rule 24(a)(2), the Council has concluded that the name of the judge in this case will not be made public.

Circuit Judge John Daniel Tinder and Chief District Judge David T. Hamilton did not participate in the consideration of this complaint.
