IN RE COMPLAINTS AGAINST TWO JUDGES

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed judicial misconduct complaints naming six judges but only two are live federal judges covered by the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act, 28 U.S.C. Section 351-364. Three are state judges and one is a deceased federal judge. The complainant is not a litigant but is filing the complaint and asking that these named judges be prosecuted for their apparent involvement as judges in criminal cases against a defendant who is now in jail. Complainant is convinced that the defendant has been unlawfully prosecuted on multiple occasions.

There is nothing in the complaint that mentions misconduct by either of the two federal judges who are alive or for that matter the other four judges as well.

Therefore this complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(iii) and Rule 11(c)(1)(D) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings.
