IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a second judicial misconduct complaint against a judge assigned to his case. This complaint is also not very clear but appears to deal with complainant not having received the transcripts that the judge ordered sent to him and his request for an extension of time.

Any complaint that is "directly related to the merits of a decision or procedural ruling" must be dismissed. 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii). See also Rule 11(c)(1)(B) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings. "Any allegation that calls into question the correctness of an official action of a judge...is merits related." Standard 2 for Assessing Compliance with the Act, *Implementation of the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act of 1980: A Report to the Chief Justice* 145 (2006).

Complainant is advised that Rule 10(a) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings provides that a complainant may be restricted from using the complaint procedures if the complainant has abused the complaint procedure.

This complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii).
