IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST THREE JUDGES

MEMORANDUM

Complainant, a defendant in a criminal case, has filed a judicial misconduct complaint against three judges. He has attached a brief statement of facts which also attacks the prosecutors in his criminal case. The allegations of judicial bias, conspiracy and violating statutes all arise from the rulings of two of the judges.

Any complaint that is “directly related to the merits of a decision or procedural ruling” must be dismissed. 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii). *See* also Rule 11(c)(1)(B) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings. “Any allegation that calls into question the correctness of an official action of a judge...is merits related.” Standard 2 for Assessing Compliance with the Act, Implementation of the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act of 1980: A Report to the Chief Justice 145 (2006). There is no judicial misconduct.

There are no allegations against the third judge so that complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(3)(A)(i).

This complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. Section 352(b)(1)(A)(i) and (ii).
