IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a judicial misconduct complaint against the judge assigned to his case. The complaint is that the judge has conspired with many, many individuals to rule against complainant. The complaint is filled with allegations of corruption of the complained about judge, other judges, and government officials. The Commentary under Rule 11 of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings provides for dismissal when the allegations lack “indicia of reliability.”

This is the third complaint filed within the last year against various judges that I have dismissed because they contain baseless allegations. Any further complaint filed under that statute that does not make a serious effort to address the effect of 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A) will be summarily dismissed, and I will order complainant to show cause why the Judicial Council should not curtail his apparently frivolous invocations of the 1980 Act. *See* Rule 10(a) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability.

This complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(iii).
