IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a judicial misconduct complaint against the judge who has adversely ruled on his judicial misconduct complaints against the three judges assigned to the four law suits that he filed.

The misconduct alleged in this complaint is that this complained about judge failed to investigate the unsupported allegations in the earlier complaints and threatened complainant with seeking an order from the Judicial Council to require complainant to post a \$1,000 bond before accepting any future complaints. The bond would be returned to complainant if the complaint was not an abuse of the misconduct complaint process. Although warned, complainant has filed this complaint which is frivolous as it contains allegations lacking sufficient evidence to raise an inference of misconduct. The complaint is dismissed as frivolous pursuant to 28 U.S.C. 352(b)(1)(A)(iii).

Complainant is given 28 days from the date of this order to respond as to why the Seventh Circuit Judicial Council should not require complainant to deposit \$1,000 before any future complaints will be reviewed. The \$1,000 deposit is neither a fine nor a filing fee. It is designed to make complainant think seriously before filing a frivolous complaint. This \$1,000 deposit will be refunded if the Chief Judge or the reviewing judge under 28 U.S.C. § 351(c) determines that the complaint has any arguable merit.
