IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST TWO JUDGES

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a judicial misconduct complaint against two judges who are assigned to complainant's two cases which have both been decided adversely to the complainant. All that is said in the complaint is that the "judge denied counsel" although this only references one of the cases and one of the judges.

Any complaint that is "directly related to the merits of a decision or procedural ruling" must be dismissed. 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii). See also Rule 11(c)(1)(B) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings. "Any allegation that calls into question the correctness of an official action of a judge...is merits related." Standard 2 for Assessing Compliance with the Act, Implementation of the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act of 1980: A Report to the Chief Justice 145 (2006).

Nothing is said about the other judge so that part of the complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(i).

This complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(i) and (ii).
