MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a judicial misconduct complaint against the judges assigned to his case. The complaint is mainly about the judges' rulings. Any complaint that is "directly related to the merits of a decision or procedural ruling" must be dismissed. 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii). See also Rule 11(c)(1)(B) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings. "Any allegation that calls into question the correctness of an official action of a judge...is merits related." Standard 2 for Assessing Compliance with the Act, *Implementation of the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act of 1980: A Report to the Chief Justice* 145 (2006). This part of the complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii).

There are also unsupported allegations of the judges favoring friends and engaging in partisan politics. There is no evidence to support any of those allegations so that part of the complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(iii).
