IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a judicial misconduct complaint against the judge who dismissed her judicial misconduct complaints against six judges pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(iii). The complainant has merely added the complained about judge to the basic complaint against the other six judges. The proper avenue to review the dismissal of the judicial misconduct complaint was a petition to review filed with the Seventh Circuit Judicial Council. Complainant did that and the petition to review was denied.

There is no judicial misconduct by the complained about judge. This complaint, like the others, is frivolous. Therefore this complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(iii).

Repetitive filing of insubstantial judicial misconduct complaints is an abuse of the provisions of the Judicial Conduct and Disabilities Act of 1980, 28 U.S.C. §§351-364. If complainant continues to abuse the provisions of the Act, I will ask the Seventh Circuit Judicial Council to require complainant to post a \$1,000 bond before any future complaints are reviewed.
