MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a third judicial misconduct complaint against judges assigned to her case. I dismissed the earlier complaints pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii) as they were “directly related to the merits of a decision or procedural ruling.” *See also* Rule 11(c)(1)(B) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings.

Repetitive filing of insubstantial judicial misconduct complaints is an abuse of the provisions of the Judicial Conduct and Disabilities Act of 1980, 28 U.S.C. §§351-364. If complainant continues to abuse the provisions of the Act, I will ask the Seventh Circuit Judicial Council to require complainant to post a \$1,000 bond before any future complaints are reviewed.

This complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(iii).
