IN RE COMPLAINTS AGAINST TWO JUDGES

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed judicial misconduct complaints against judges assigned to his cases. The complaints are similar in their allegations of misconduct but neither has any support for the allegations. The complainant filed similar complaints against both judges which I dismissed earlier this year.

Repetitive filing of insubstantial judicial misconduct complaints is an abuse of the provisions of the Judicial Conduct and Disabilities Act of 1980, 28 U.S.C. §§351-364. If complainant continues to abuse the provisions of the Act, I will ask the Seventh Circuit Judicial Council to require complainant to post a \$1,000 bond before any future complaints are reviewed.

These complaints are dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(iii) as they are frivolous.
