IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE

MEMORANDUM

This is complainant's fourth judicial misconduct complaint in a year. I dismissed the last three and this one is going to be dismissed as well. The substance of this complaint concerns the judge's decisions and delay in ruling. There has not been any undue delay in handling complainant's case. As to his allegations about erroneous rulings, complainant knows he can appeal and has done so.

When I dismissed the last complaint, I warned him that repetitive filing of insubstantial judicial misconduct complaints is an abuse of the provisions of the Judicial Conduct and Disabilities Act of 1980, 28 U.S.C. § § 351-364.

This complaint is dismissed as frivolous pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii). Complainant has until August 10, 2016, to respond as to why he should not be required to post a \$1,000 bond with any future complaint which would be returned if the complaint was not frivolous.
