IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE

MEMORANDUM

The complaint is that the judge dismissed the underlying complaint without any court hearings. That is done frequently in courts and is not misconduct. If the judge erred in the dismissal, the remedy is an appeal, not a misconduct complaint.

Complainant also complains that the judge was biased as evidenced by the judge's review of the court's public docket and stating that many of complainant's other complaints had been dismissed as meritless. The judge then went on to advise complainant that the filing of meritless complaints could result in sanctions or limitations on filing of additional complaints.

None of the judge's statements or actions alleged in this complaint constitute misconduct. This complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(iii).
