IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a second complaint against a judge. I dismissed the earlier complaint as frivolous and I do the same with this one. Less than two weeks ago I included in my dismissal order a warning that filing frivolous complaints is an abuse of the provisions of the Judicial Conduct and Disabilities Act of 1980, 28 U.S.C. § 351-364, and that if he continued the Seventh Circuit Judicial Council might require him to post a \$1,000 bond before allowing him to file any further complaints. See Rule 10(a) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings.

Complainant has until October 2, 2017 to respond as to why he should not be required to post a \$1,000 bond with any future complaint which would be returned if the complaint was not frivolous.
