IN RE COMPLAINTS AGAINST TWO JUDGES

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed two judicial misconduct complaints against judges assigned to his case. The basic complaint arises from the judges' adverse rulings on complainant's requests for information about the signature of the grand jury foreman on the indictment. Any complaint that is "directly related to the merits of a decision or procedural ruling" must be dismissed. 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii). *See also* Rule 11(c)(1)(B) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings. "Any allegation that calls into question the correctness of an official action of a judge...is merits related." Standard 2 for Assessing Compliance with the Act, *Implementation of the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act of 1980: A Report to the Chief Justice* 145 (2006).

These complaints are dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii).
