IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a complaint against the district judge assigned to his case and a deputy clerk. The Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings only apply to judges so the complaint against the deputy clerk is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(i) as it is not in conformity with § 351(a).

The complaint about the judge is that the judge allegedly called for court security officers to remove complainant from the courtroom. Complainant states that he was in the courtroom for a previously noticed hearing. The complainant states that the deputy clerk told the complainant several times that there would be no hearing as his motions were denied. Nothing alleged in this complaint constitutes judicial misconduct so it is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii).

This complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(i) and (iii).
