IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a judicial misconduct complaint against the judge assigned to her case. The complaint alleges that the judge is biased and has “engaged in conduct in violation of the Supreme Law of the Land.” The basis for the complaint is that the judge allegedly overlooked facts in dismissing the underlying complaint.

Any complaint that is “directly related to the merits of a decision or procedural ruling” must be dismissed. 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii). *See also* Rule 11(c)(1)(B) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings. “Any allegation that calls into question the correctness of an official action of a judge...is merits related.” Standard 2 for Assessing Compliance with the Act, *Implementation of the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act of 1980: A Report to the Chief Justice* 145 (2006). Nothing other than the judge’s adverse ruling is provided in support of the allegations.

This complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(ii).
