IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE:

MEMORANDUM

Complainant filed a misconduct complaint against the judge who ordered him arrested and detained pending the government's petition for revocation of supervised release. He states that the judge issued a defective arrest warrant and improperly ordered certain pleadings stricken from the record. These decisions are merits related and not cognizable misconduct. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii); R. FOR JUD.-CONDUCT & JUD.-DISABILITY PROC. 4(b)(1). To the extent that complainant tries to recast these claims as ex parte communications, "stonewalling," and discrimination toward complainant, the allegations are wholly unsupported and frivolous. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii); JUD.-CONDUCT PROC. R. 11(c)(1)(D).

The complaint is dismissed pursuant to § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii) and (iii).
