IN RE COMPLAINTS AGAINST FIVE JUDGES

MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

The complainant filed a misconduct complaint against five federal judges, four state-court judges, two attorneys, and one corporation. The allegations against the state-court judges, attorneys, and corporation are beyond the purview of the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act. 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(i). The remaining allegations are both nonsensical and appear to be directly related to the merits of the judges' decisions and thus are not proper grounds for a misconduct complaint. *Id.* § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii), (iii); RULES FOR JUD.-MISCONDUCT & JUD.-DISABILITY PROC. 4(b)(1).

For the foregoing reasons, the five complaints are dismissed pursuant to § 352(b)(1)(A)(i), (ii), and (iii). The complainant may petition the Judicial Council of the Seventh Circuit for review of this order in accordance with Rule 18(b) of the *Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings*. 28 U.S.C. § 352(c); see RULES FOR JUD.-CONDUCT & JUD.-DISABILITY PROC. 11(g)(3). A petition for review must be filed in the clerk's office of the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit not later than 42 days of the date of this order.
