IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE

MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

The complainant filed a misconduct complaint against a judge who sits in the court where the complainant has civil cases pending before other judges. As reflected in the attachments to the complaint, the allegations concern the rulings of a different judge. The complaint against the named judge is wholly unsupported and must be dismissed. 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii); RULES FOR JUD.-CONDUCT & JUD.-DISABILITY PROC. r. 11(c)(1)(D).

Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed pursuant to § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii). The complainant may petition the Judicial Council of the Seventh Circuit for review of this order in accordance with Rule 18(b) of the *Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings*. 28 U.S.C. § 352(c); *see* RULES FOR JUD.-CONDUCT & JUD.-DISABILITY PROC. r. 11(g)(3). A petition for review must be filed in the clerk's office of the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit not later than 42 days of the date of this order.
